RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRY FEE \$5.00 PER HEAD. All entry applications must be in the Fair Office by Friday, July 6, 2007. Application will be “date stamped” and pen placement will be determined by order applications were received at the Fair Office. This will be strictly enforced.

ONLY THREE (3) ANIMALS ALLOWED PER LOT NUMBER, PER EXHIBITOR. NO EXCEPTIONS. Champion awards will only be issued by breeder against breeder. All animals must arrive between 4:00 p.m. and 8 p.m., Tuesday, August 7. 4-H animals have first placement, with remaining space to open class. If more animals are entered than there is housing, the exhibitors will be limited to one animal each with top animals being first to be stalled. Check judging time with the Superintendent. Registration papers must be shown on all purebred cattle and available for visual inspection by the Superintendent at any time requested. Animals must be in show condition and not of poor body weight. The Western Montana Fair will furnish initial bedding. Exhibitors must provide their own feed. Exhibitors must be on hand at all times to properly care for their cattle. Animals must be halter broke and under control at all

times while on the grounds. If it is determined that an animal is not manageable, it must be removed from the grounds. Blankets must be kept off the animals whenever the Superintendent determines there are sufficient members of the public on hand to view the cattle exhibits. January 1st has been selected as the date for determining ages. Because of inadequate barn space, we cannot accept bulls over 6 months of age. No Grade bulls will be accepted. **4-H and FFA members may enter animals in Open Class competition, if Open Class regulations have been met.**

Exhibitors may now purchase a Season Pass anytime through Monday, August 5, 5 p.m.

All vehicles with animals must enter at the Russell Street gate at the south end of the Hockey Rink and exit through the new South Avenue gate at the north end of the Llama Barn. Right turns only onto South Avenue. The gate will open at 6:00 a.m. for feeding and stall cleaning only.

No champion awards will be made unless there is competition.

Exhibits not properly mounted will not be displayed or judged.

All pictures must be appropriately framed with screw eyes and wire for hanging. All drawings must be properly mounted on heavy tag or poster board with fine wire or cord attached for hanging or use stick on hangers.

SPECIAL CLASS - Fair Commission Selection

6000 The subject of the painting or drawing must be "OUR FAIR" of either modern or early times of any fair subject(s). The painting must have been made within the last two years. The Fair Commission *may* purchase the winning entry in this class, with all rights, for \$200.00. This class is open to all levels. It will be judged like any Fair entry, with the final selection to be made by the Fair Commission. Pictures must be 14" x 20" or larger and they must also be framed to be eligible. Any of the following media will be accepted: oil, acrylic, watercolor, mixed medium or pastel. Second and third place ribbons will also be presented, but constitute **no cash award**. It is understood that the purchased painting will be the sole property of the Western Montana Fair and may be used or reproduced at the Fair Commission's discretion.
